### **SHELTER WISH LIST**

These items help provide our staff with materials needed to run the shelter.

#### **Office Supplies:**

Pens (not pencils), Copy paper (8 ½ x 11), Colored paper (8 ½ x 11), Post-it notes, Highlighters, Message books, Postage stamps, 1/3 tab file folders, Unlined index cards, White business envelopes, 10 x 13 clasp envelopes, Glue sticks, Staplers and staples, ¾” tape (for tape dispensers), Legal pads, Address labels, 3 ring binders, extension chords and surge protectors

**Shelter & Animal Supplies:** Bleach, Dishwashing soap, Paper towels & toilet paper, Stainless steel food & water bowls, Brooms, Sponges, squeegees and scouring pads & scrub brushes, Towels and blankets, newspaper, Spray bottles, Latex gloves, Heavy duty hoses & spray nozzles, Animal safe de-icer, Washable dog and cat toys (specifically, hard rubber toys like big kahunnas or kongs), Rawhide chews, Unopened bags of Science Diet dry dog or cat food, Dog biscuits and cat treats, Kitty Litter, Pooper Scoopers, Small washable cat & hard plastic dog beds, preferably Kuranda Dog Beds ([www.kuranda.com](http://www.kuranda.com)), heating pads for cats (preferably Snuggle Safe heating pads), Canned dog & cat food, Frontline, Capstar, Cat and dog brushes, Carrots and mixed greens for rabbits.

#### **Gardening & Repair Supplies**

Gardening Tools, regular tools, Mulch and topsoil, Weed killer, Plant fertilizer, Hoses and nozzles, Hose Holders, Perennial Flowers and Shrubs, Ground Cover, Gardening Gloves, Watering Cans, Wheel Barrow, Rubber gloves

### **Shelter Beautification**

Building alternate storage structures, organizing current storage structures, building mobile storage structures for our dog beds and cat carriers, supplying and/or installing shelving units (for our basements, sheds, and shelter rooms), paving or filling of potholes in the shelter parking lot (in front and behind the shelter), donating a used or new dryer or washer, repairs to our front sign and barn, fencing.
